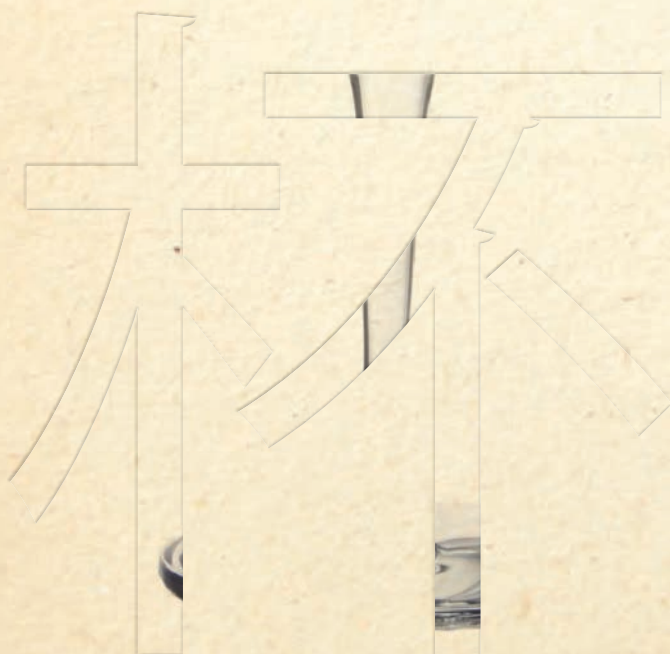
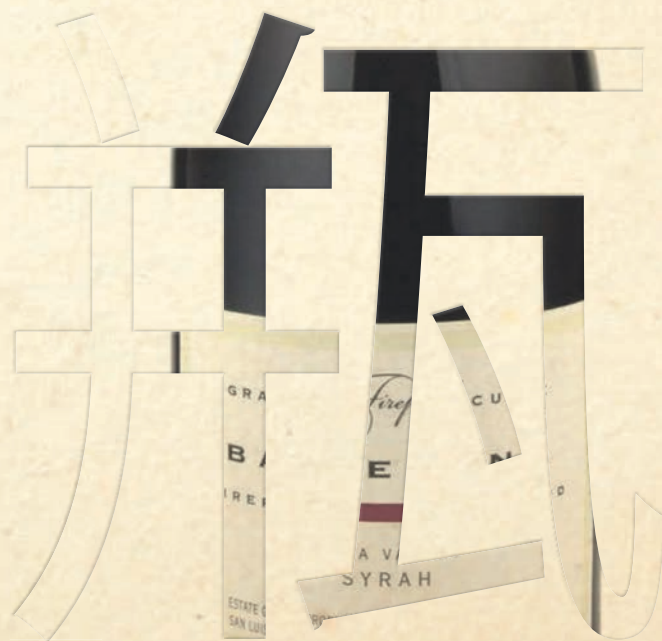
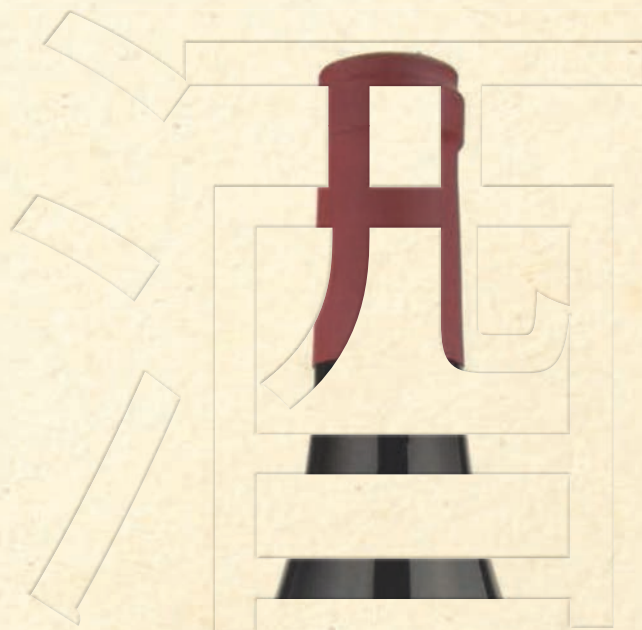

CHARDONNAY | [shär dn-a] |, noun

A white grape originally grown in the Burgundy region of France, & now throughout the wine-producing world. **ORIGIN:** < French chardon (n) ay [Buttery & oaky w/ hints of vanilla, pineapple, peach, & green apple flavors & a smooth finish]

RIESLING | [r s l ng/ r z-leng] |, noun

A variety of grape grown in cool areas, especially in Germany & the Pacific Northwest.

ORIGIN: from German, from earlier Rüssling. [Light-to-medium bodied w/ apricot, honey suckle, & pear flavors w/ a dry finish]

PINOT GRIGIO | [peenō greejō] |, noun

A crisp dry white wine made from a variety of white grapes grown mainly in Italy & France.

ORIGIN: Italian, literally, gray Pinot [Medium-to-full bodied wine, a rich somewhat floral bouquet, tropical flavors of honey suckle, tangerine, & apricot]

SAUVIGNON BLANC | [soh-vin-yohn blahngk] |, noun

A green-skinned grape variety which originates from the Bordeaux region of France. ORIGIN: The grape most likely gets its name from the French word sauvage [“wild”] and blanc [“white”] due to its early origins as an indigenous grape in South West France.

[Light-bodied, crisp wine w/ fig, lemon, & grassy tones]

VIOGNIER | [vee ànn yáy] |, noun

A typically dry white wine made from a variety of grape originally grown mainly in the Rhône valley of France but now cultivated elsewhere. ORIGIN: Presumed to be an ancient grape, possibly originating in Dalmatia [present day Croatia] & then brought to Rhône by the Romans. [Medium-bodied wine w/ flamboyant peach & floral aromatics, smooth texture & generally soft acidity]

RED WINES

MALBEC | [Mahl-bek] |, noun

A black grape originally grown in the Bordeaux region of France & now in Argentina and Chile, used for making wine. ORIGIN: Theory - named after a Hungarian peasant who first spread the grape variety throughout France. [Full-bodied, dark wine w/ blackberry, plum, tobacco, & spice palate]

CABERNET SAUVIGNON | [kábbər nay sō veen yón] |, noun

A premium red grape used in winemaking, especially in the Bordeaux region of France & in northern California. ORIGIN: The word “Sauvignon” is believed to be derived from the French word sauvage meaning “wild” and as a reference to the grape being a wild *Vitis vinifera* vine native to France. [Full-Bodied w/ black currant, coffee, & dark chocolate notes w/ a long finish]

MERLOT | [mər ló] |, noun

Merlot is a robust grape that can grow in a variety of soils conditions, & is very prominent in the Bordeaux region of France. ORIGIN: The name Merlot is thought to derive from the Old French word for young blackbird, merlot, a diminutive of merle, the blackbird [Turdus merula], probably from the color of the grape [Medium-body with hints of berry, plum, & currant.]

PINOT NOIR | [peəñō nwáar] |, noun

A red wine made from a variety of black grape originally grown in the Burgundy region of France.
ORIGIN: < French, “Black Pinot” [grape variety] < pin “pine cone”; from the shape of the grape clusters
[Medium-bodied & silky w/ red cherry, strawberry, & smoky earth tones]

Saké | [SAH-kee] |, noun

An alcoholic beverage of Japanese origin that is made from fermented rice.
ORIGIN: nihonshu [日本酒, "Japanese liquor"]. The earliest reference to the use of alcohol in Japan is recorded in the Book of Wei in the Records of the Three Kingdoms. [Filtered/unfiltered][Sweet to dry][Full-bodied/light-bodied]

Something resembling or suggesting a drink as being a mixture of often diverse elements or ingredients. ORIGIN: 1800–10, Americanism; Origin obscure; none of numerous attempts to explain the orig. of this word or its relationship to cocktail have won general acceptance

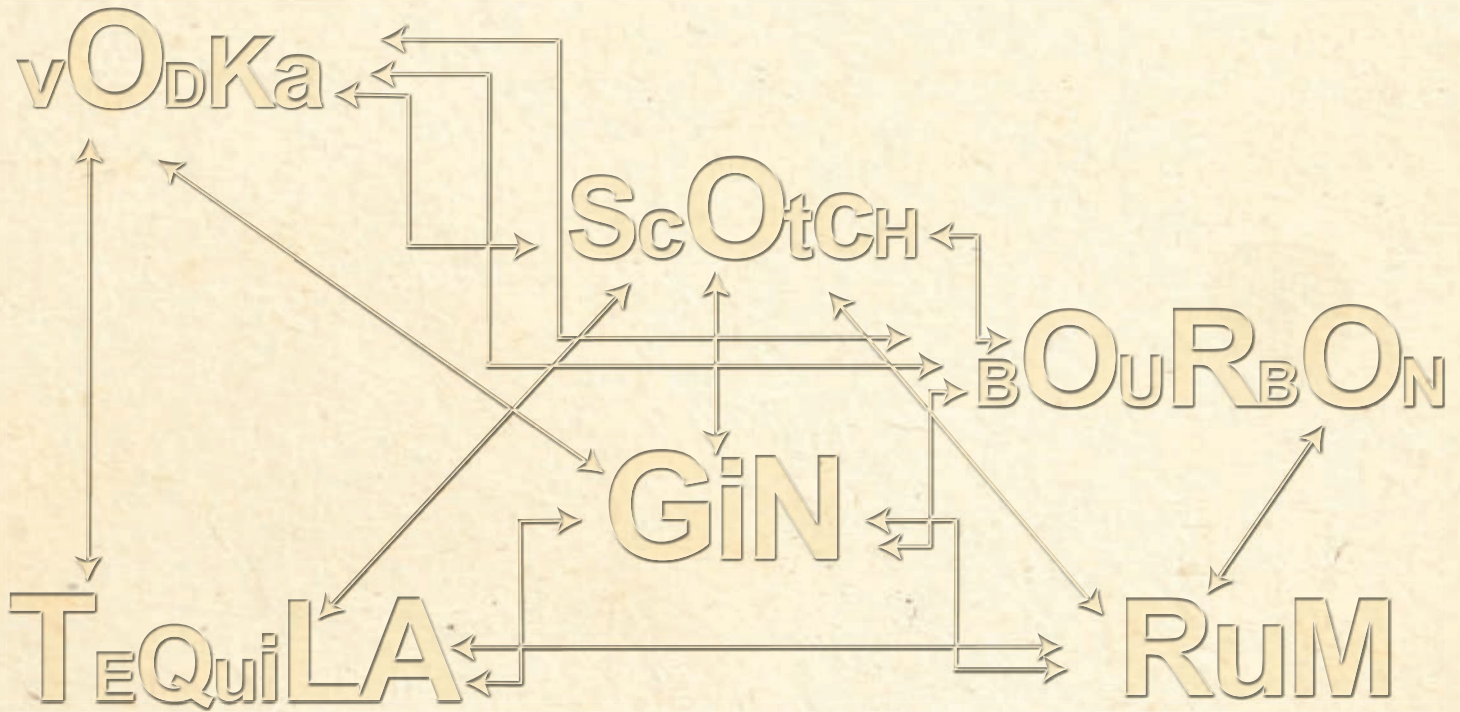
MARTINI | [mär T-nee] |, noun

An alcoholic beverage made by brewing and fermentation from cereals - usually malted barley, and flavored with hops and the like for a slightly bitter taste. ORIGIN: before 1000; Middle English bere, Old English bēor; cognate with Old Saxon, Old High German bior, Middle Low German, Middle Dutch bēr, Dutch, German Bier (Old Norse bjōrr, probably < OE); of disputed and ambiguous orig.
